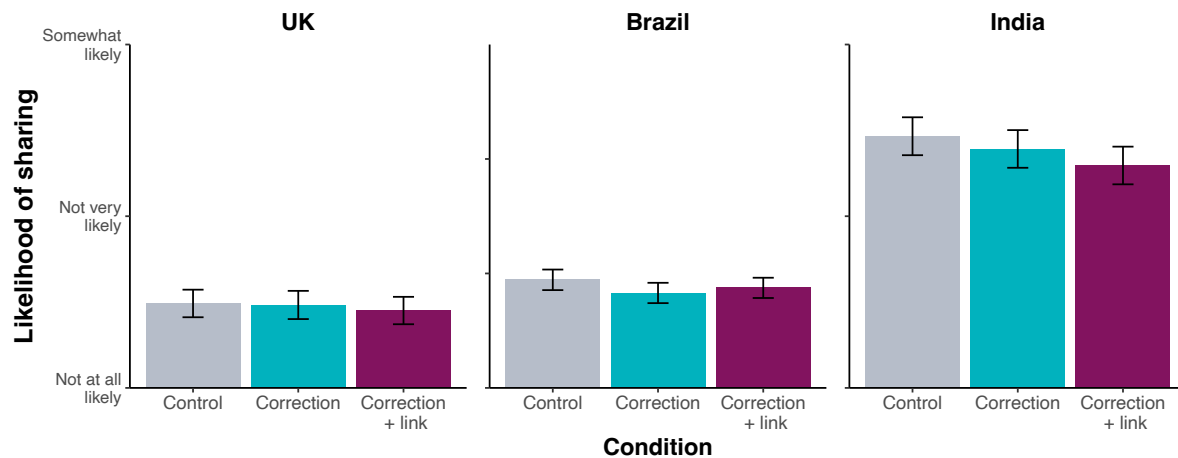

The error bars represent the 95% confidence intervals. The full likelihood of sharing scale also includes a fourth point, “very likely.”
